



Match Day Checklist for Managers

Am I ready for the game?

- Have you checked and communicated where and when you are playing?
- Do you know which players are available?
- If wet weather, have you checked if the field is open, or if the game has been moved?
- Is your team on set up or pack up duty, and have you organised volunteers?
- Have you printed your match sheet?
- Have you organised your referee payments?
- Do you have your player cards?
- Do you have your coach/manager cards and official's vests?
- Is there someone who can act as ground official if needed?
- Do you have hand sanitiser, tissues and a rubbish bag in your kit?
- Have you reminded players to let you know if they are unwell and can't play?
- If you are borrowing players, have you checked they are eligible?

At the game:

- Arrive in time to organise your team to set up if on duty
- Make sure your team observes COVID19 safe protocols for changeover of games
- Cross out any absent players on the match sheet, add any borrowed players (you must have their cards); add any jersey numbers.
- Introduce yourself to the ground officials, referees and opposition team officials
- Pay the referees and make sure your team have their cards ready to go on the pitch
- Encourage your players to use hand sanitiser and practice safe hygiene
- Make sure your team shows respect at all times
- Make sure your bench observes COVID19 safe protocols (physical distance on the bench)
- Do not argue with ground officials, do what they ask you to do at all times
- Encourage fair play – applaud good play by both teams, and be encouraging at all times

After the game:

- Build a culture of fair play – thank your opposition regardless of the outcome of the game
- Confirm the score and sign the match sheet
- Ask the referee to add to the comments section and injuries section if applicable
- Make sure you have your cards before you leave the pitch
- Pack up or assist with pack up if you are the last game
- Make sure your team leaves the pitch promptly and observes COVID19 safe protocols
- If you are the home team, take your match sheet to the Ewen Park canteen
- If you are the away team, take a photo of your match sheet
