


# EXECUTIVE ROLE VACANT TREASURER

#### **2021** Congratulations

Congratulations to all of our teams and players for their commitment and effort through a challenging and unexpectedly short 2021 season. While we did not get to have the usual fun of finals, four of our teams were declared Premiers for the season in their divisions. This reflects their sustained effort week by week, game by game throughout the season. Huge congratulations to the **12/2A girls**, the **13/2 girls**, the **13/3 mixed** and the **AA4A teams**. The three juniors teams were undefeated throughout the season, which is a great record of consistency and reflects the effort of the players, the coaches and the managers (and of course the wonderful parents).

And a special shout out to Maree Paradisis from our Grace Martin Trophy team, who this season reached an amazing tally of 96 games. We expected Maree to reach the milestone of her 100th game in the Grace Martin Trophy competition this season, but COVID-19 put a stop to that.







Special congratulations also to **Frank Calcagno** from our Bill Brackenbury Cup team who won the Golden Boot Award for the BBC Competition for 2021. Frank was awarded the trophy at the CDSFA AGM in November.



Also congratulations to **Tessa Copp** who reached a tally of 90 games this season before an ACL injury ended her football for the season. We have some amazing sustained effort from players in our club, and Maree and Tessa are standouts in this!







We play in the Canterbury District Soccer Football Association, which is one of the longest standing football institutions in the country. 2022 marks the Centenary season for the Association, and was launched on 24 January 2022 with an event involving Federal, State and local Council politicians, and MCed by football media legend Simon Hill.

Hurlstone Park Wanderers has a wonderful legacy within the Association. We were ourselves founded in 1924, and so we are not only one of oldest and longest running clubs, but we have also made our mark throughout the history of the Association. The premier men's competition the Bill Brackenbury Cup is named for our founder.



It was fantastic to have Rocky and Abby, two of our wonderful game leaders take part in the celebrations, as the two game leaders selected to officiate small sided games following the speeches. Rocky and Abby did a wonderful job and represented us very well, showing off their experience and maturity as game leaders.

During 2022 there will be many more opportunities to celebrate the Association's Centenary and our Club's contribution to this amazing history of community sport.

#### Life members

I'd like to congratulate our new life members, who were nominated and approved at the 2021 AGM. These nominations recognise amazing service to the club and what is notable is that we have some younger club members recognised this year – people who have put in amazing service over many years for the club.


Congratulations to **Anthony Maher**, our retiring Treasurer, and to **Lauren Paddon**, longstanding captain of the GMT team, and **Gemma Viney**, who has been our miniref/game leader coordinator for many years as well as being a longstanding coach and player within the club.





We were very excited to receive the news last year that our application for a Greater Cities Sports Fund grant was successful. We received the largest grant that can be awarded under the scheme - \$1 million towards our new canteen, amenities block and club house at Ewen Park. This is part of our overall infrastructure improvement plan, that we are aiming to undertake over the next five years (and that started with the new lights at Ewen in 2020). The success was a huge effort by the Club and Committee, with help from many volunteers and from other local sporting organisations, but also with great support from CDSFA and the Canterbury Bankstown Council, who will manage the project on our behalf.

We want to recognise as well the fact that our success was in no small part due to the work that has gone before the current Committee, and particularly to fundraising that had been done by our members over the previous two decades that put us in good stead to be able to commit the required co-contribution.





We will bring you more news over the year about the plans for the new clubhouse, but our expectation is that the site preparations will begin late in this season, with the aim of completion ready for Season 2023.

A very big thank you to our infrastructure committee, Phil Martin, Gerry Choate, Janice Leahy and Rosalie Viney.

Very excitingly, we can give you a further update that the CDSFA Board has approved funding from their infrastructure improvement fund of \$100,000 to help us to complete the work as a state of the art facility – this funding will be forthcoming based on plans submitted by the Club for key parts of the fitout of the facility, including security, audio-visual and the canteen. This is a wonderful contribution, and we are very grateful to the Association's Board and CEO for the support of our club and members that this very significant contribution represents.

We were also successful with a much smaller grant to contribute to infrastructure at Beaman Park. We are working with Council for a plan for the best way to use these funds to improve facilities at Beaman.
