

## Information about Registration Fees for 2023

Registration fees are based on the age of the player. Our fees are **all inclusive for the season**, and cover pre-season games, all games for the season, all referee fees, gear (shorts, socks and jersey). We also make skills training available for our players during the season.

You may notice that this is an increase in fees from 2022. In 2019 the committee agreed to a constant 3% per annum increase in fees to keep in line with the then inflation rate. In subsequent years due to Covid, we have not increased fees by 3% each year, so have fallen behind the inflation rate in fees. Nonetheless, the costs of running the club have increased in line with inflation, which is now well above 3%. Our 2023 fees represent a 3% increase in the club's share of fees from 2022, which is still less than the CPI increase, but we have also passed on the full increase in the governing body (Football Canterbury, Football NSW and Football Australia) fees, which we have absorbed for the past two years. We will continue to provide socks and shorts, coaching support, referee fees and pre-season game opportunities as part of our fees, and to provide the skills training for junior players and goal keepers.

We offer a family discount for families where there are three or more players from the same family who are playing, provided that the third and subsequent registrations are for a junior player. The family discount is provided as a rebate after registration, and the link to the form is [here](#).
