



Information about Registration Fees for 2024

Our fees are **all inclusive for the season**, and cover pre-season games, all games for the season, ground hire for training and games, ground management costs, all referee fees, gear (shorts, socks and jersey). We also make skills training available for our players during the season. Registration fees are based on the age of the player and are in the table below.

We have had to increase fees over the 2023 amounts, because of increase in governing body and insurance costs to ensure we cover our costs of playing football. The current inflation rate is 5.7%. Our 2024 fees represent an approximate 5% increase in fees from 2023, which is still less than the CPI increase, and is largely driven by increases in the governing body fees (Football Canterbury, Football NSW and Football Australia). These increases range from \$5 for the Little Lions through to \$20 for adults. We continue to be a volunteer run club and our fees are set to cover the cost of playing football.

Current Active Kids vouchers will still be redeemable at registration up until 31st January 2024. After 1st February 2024, there is a new means tested Active Kids Scheme, and these vouchers will not be available until after 1st February 2024.

We offer a family discount for families where there are three or more players from the same family who are playing, provided that the third and subsequent registrations are for a junior player. The family discount is provided as a rebate after registration, and the link to the form is [here](#).
